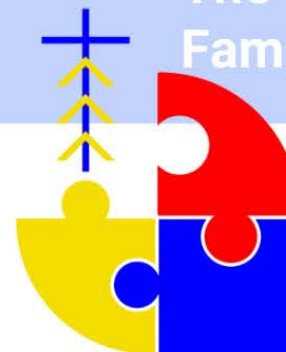
He and his wife, Lori, have six children and two grandchildren and reside near Nashville, Tennessee.
